Year Group News

Foundation Stage We are ending the term with a spring in our step and joy in our hearts. We couldn't feel more proud of our children who are already establishing a love of books and are trying to write CVC words independently using Fred talk as well as writing numbers to 5 with confidence. Week 1 of term 2 will see us going on an adventure involving castles and giants! We will be using the text, 'Shh..' to inspire our provision. The children will be building a simple sentence and creating little books with flaps. They will be building castles, using the language of size and making a giant's stew in the mud kitchen. The children will also be introduced to the number 6, exploring formation, ordering, counting and arrays as well as 6 in real life contexts. Have a wonderful half term break! Get outside and have some fun!

Year 1 Year 1 will be launching into their exciting new Dinosaur Planet topic with a morning of dinosaur investigations. Children will explore bones and footprints, dig in the sand for fossils and learn the names of some well known dinosaurs. Look out for the knowledge organiser being sent home this week and a special dinosaur themed homework! On Thursday, children will also be continuing their R.E learning on special places and heading off to visit the local church. In Maths, children will be starting a new unit on Addition and Subtraction. Please remember to send PE kits back to school after the break.


Year 2 Next term in Year 2 we will be immersing ourselves in our new topic, Dinosaur Planet! The children will be experiencing a range of exciting activities looking at fossils, types of dinosaurs and their environments. In Literacy, we will be reading and re-enacting 'Where the Wild Things Are' and using this as a basis for our writing. In Art, we will sketching dinosaurs and looking closely to add all their fantastic details.

Year 3 In Maths this week, we have been continuing to develop our knowledge of subtraction and addition. We are confident with using equipment to help us add and subtract multiples of ten and one hundred. We have completed our report writing and have produced some fantastic reports to explain why we should not pollute our rivers. We would like to take this opportunity to say thank you for all the excellent homework that has been completed and your support with your children's reading and spelling at home.

Next week's virtue is...... **Assertiveness** Disposed to or characterized by bold or confident statements and behaviour. **Year 4** Year 4 have settled in brilliantly and had a great term studying 'The Blue Abyss.' Next, we move to 'Playlist,' starting with how music and art are linked, and particularly how jazz inspired Paul Klee and Wassily Kandinsky. In English, we will be studying 'The Town Musicians of Bremen' and retelling the story verbally with actions, thinking about how the tone of our voice can add interest for our listeners. In Maths, we will be looking at efficient methods of subtraction and how these can help us to calculate mentally.

Year 5 It has been an exciting week in Year 5 as we have been busy preparing for an ancient Egyptian funeral. The children have been required to work as a team to build and decorate a sarcophagus, practised their embalming skills by wrapping each other up in bandages and were disgusted when observing some organs in a canopic jar! It has been a creative and enjoyable end to our Pharaohs topic. In English, the children have written newspaper articles about the death of Tutankhamun. Your children have worked incredibly hard this term and they should feel very proud of their achievements in Year 5 so far. We hope that the term break provides an opportunity for the children to reflect on how they can build on their learning and progress throughout Term 2.

Year 6 After half term, Year 6 will begin their new topic with an exciting memorable experience. A polar explorer will visit Goosewell to talk about their experiences in the Arctic. Throughout the day, the children will have the opportunity to try on some polar equipment, build gloopy glaciers and plan their own expedition to a polar region. In Maths, we will continue to develop our understanding of numbers including square numbers, cubed numbers and primes. Our writing lessons will see us study Jack London's novel 'White Fang' which will build up to the children writing a rags to riches tale. We are looking forward to immersing ourselves in our new topic and studying all things icy! We hope everyone has a great break.
