The idea was to create a legacy piece of work that children across the city of Plymouth to show what it is like to be in a Military family. Each square represents a family in our city with a link to the Armed Forces. Over 400 squares were completed, and it took time to put them together and for them to be hung in various establishments across the city.

David Preece - Captain of Base at HMS Drake HMNB Devonport was overjoyed at the contributions and spent time looking at the banner in detail, it is now hung in the Chaplaincy Centre – The Haven, where it can be seen in the stairwell. The banner in HMS Drake is primarily those who stated they are Royal Navy families.

Families of Royal Marines are represented at 3 Brigade Headquarters RM Barracks at Stonehouse, the banner there is hung in the Aggie's lounge along the corridor from the gym.

We didn't want to omit our families in the Army, so a 3rd banner will be sent to the Citadel and a 4th banner seen at Crownhill Community Centre.
