FROGS is at risk of closing because we do not have enough volunteers. Without FROGS our children will miss out on many of the fundamental activities we expect during their primary years. It is sad to see other schools in our area offering fantastic experiences and events that we cannot replicate. Sadly we recently had to cancel our planned Summer fete and discos.

Together we can change this! We are a school of over 400 and we are calling on parents, grandparents, carers etc to help. Please spend a minute or two reading through to find out how you can help.

You may not know this but the funds from FROGS contributes massively to Goosewell. We fund the lighting of the Christmas tree, subsidise school trips, provide the stock for the reading vending machine, organise discos and fetes to name but a few.

Sadly many of our children have never experienced any of these activities - mainly due to the knock on effects of covid and parents leaving as their children move on to secondary school.

HOW CAN I HELP?

As much or little as you can! We know how valuable free time is when you have a busy family life so we have created roles to suit everyone. Whether you want an active planning role, be an event volunteer or just send us your thoughts we want to hear from you!

Committee

We need at least 8 committee members to keep running (4 of these are named roles). Without a full committee we will not meet our constitution and be able to continue.

We typically have 6 meetings per year (either in person or by zoom) and break off into sub groups for event planning. You can expect to have tasks delegated to you such as designing posters, helping at events, obtaining quotes etc.

Event support

We need a list of parents/grandparents/carers that we can call upon to support our activities - a 'turn up on the day' job designed not to take up too much of your time. When we have events such as discos/summers fetes we will call upon our volunteers to help.

For some events you will require a DBS, there is no charge for this and it is organised by the school office.
