Clubs

All of our Clubs are now fully subscribed for Term 2. All children will have the opportunity to participate in an afterschool sports club throughout the year. You will only be able to sign your child up for one sports club throughout the year, until all children have participated, should they want to. A text will be sent 24 hours prior to the opening of the booking window.

Road Safety Around the School

This is an appeal to all road users, particularly car drivers, around the Goosewell site. On behalf of the entire Goosewell community - children, staff, families and neighbours we ask that you drive and park safely around the school at the start and end of each school day. Under no circumstances should the school car park be used as a cut through, or for parking to collect/drop off a child without a permit. The disabled spaces in the school car park are out of bounds as these are required for the School Transport Service to collect and pick up children from the school. Parking in these spaces puts our children and staff at risk. Please also be mindful of parking on Goosewell Park Road, particularly during bad weather conditions as it is vital that children walking to school unaccompanied are visible when crossing the roads. Mounting the pavements and blocking driveways compromises the safety of everyone, and the safety of all of our children and families is paramount - your support and understanding is appreciated. Next term, the local PCSO and Plymouth City Council's road safety team will be patrolling the area around the school.




Harvest 2023:
