- Monday 1st June final pre-visit London meeting.



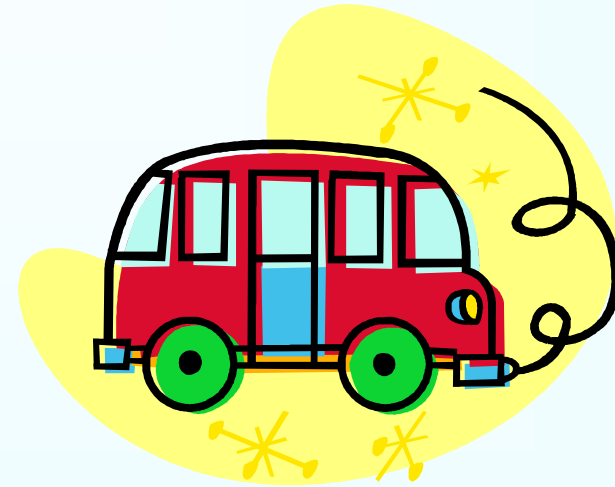
Questions

What will the children need to take?

- Medical information/ medication to be looked after by teachers

A rucksack containing:

- Pyjamas / nightie
- Small soft toy for bedtime (optional)
- Overnight toiletries
- Change of underwear
- London 2018 T shirt for Day 2
- A lightweight, waterproof jacket (just in case)



Very small rucksack for water, camera, food etc.

- Please make sure *everything* is named.
- Children will need to be wearing a clean, smart school uniform with a school jumper or cardigan, regardless of weather. They also need to be wearing their sensible, black school shoes and NOT trainers or sandals.



Children will also need:

- Book or travel game/toy for the journey.
 - Camera (optional) Disposable ones are recommended.
 - A carrier bag containing a packed lunch.
 - Drinks, but no glass bottles or fizzy please.
 - Additional bottle of water will be a good idea given that the weather may be very warm.
